The humpback whale (*Megaptera novaeangliae*) is a baleen whale and a rorqual whale that sings amazing and beautiful songs. It performs complex and cooperative feeding techniques. It has a bulky head with bumpy protuberances (tubercles), each with a bristle. Humpbacks are acrobats of the ocean, breaching and slapping the water. They live in pods and have 2 blowholes.

DESCRIPTION: The humpback whale was given its common name because of the shape of its dorsal (back) fin and the way it looks when the animal is diving. Its scientific name, *Megaptera*, means, "large-winged" and refers to its long, white, wing-like flippers that are often as long as one-third of the animal's body length.

The Humpback whale breathe air at the surface of the water through 2 blowholes located near the top of the head. Their blow is a double stream of spray that rises 10-13 feet (3.1-4 m) above the surface of the water.
